RECYCLABLE

Being made up of natural fibers, the liners can be recycled with other #60 textiles.

The poly film is a low-density polyethylene resin that can be recycled at your local drop off location with other #4 plastics.

BIODEGRADABLE

Natural Fiber Pads are biodegradable and compostable as tested by an independent third-party laboratory using ASTM test standards.

Because cotton is a plant, It will naturally go back to the soil from which it was made.

Simply flatten the box and recycle with the rest of your cardboard and paper.

NATURAL FIBER : LINERS.

Our natural fiber pads are fully recyclable. Remove them from the poly film and recycle where #60 cotton is accepted.

North Face, and Columbia. Drop off the liners at participating stores.

For those who don't have convenient access to these drop-off locations, you can send the liners back to us, or even throw them away as they will fully biodegrade.

POLY FILM.

After separating the poly film from the natural fiber pads, the poly film can be recycled with the rest of your #4 plastic bags.

GEL PACKS.

Let the gel packs melt completely, snip the corner off a pack, empty into trash and recycle the outer covering with other #4 plastics.
